MVPC Membership

MVPC membership dues are \$30 per individual membership or \$40 for a household membership.

Active Members of MVPC are eligible to enter all MVPC club competitions, also known as salons, as well as competitions sponsored by Camera Council, PSA, and N4C. Active Members may also participate in club activities and attend Focus Nights.

Activities and Focus Nights

MVPC plans activities throughout the year that are open to all active Members of the club. These activities may last for an hour or for as long as an entire weekend. The activities provide Members with the opportunity to socialize and learn techniques from other Members.

MVPC holds Focus Nights on the third Thursday of each month at the **Eagan Community Center**. Focus Nights are an opportunity for Members to learn techniques regarding a specific subject. The type of Focus Night may vary from a classroom setting to shooting opportunities working with models and/or elements such as lighting, water, and fire.
