

Nature Photography. (adapted from N4C) Nature photography is simply the recording of our natural world by some photographic means. Included are all branches of nature except Archeology and Anthropology.

a) No photograph is worth the distress or injury to any wild creature.

b) The hand of man shall not be present in any nature entry except where wild birds or animals have invaded man's world such as fence posts and other manmade objects freely adapted for use by wild creatures. Photographs at bird feeders are not acceptable if any part of a man made feeder is shown in the photograph.

c) Banding or tagging on nature subjects is acceptable.

d) Photographs taken in zoos, animal farms or game farms are acceptable as long as the setting remains natural and the hand of man is not visible.

e) Cultivated plants, domestic animals and pets are not acceptable and should be entered in other categories.

f) There are no restrictions on the image processing except that it must look natural and not obvious that post processing has been performed.
